







School Goals

For the 2019-2020 school year there are three goals we would like to achieve. The first is to improve the Ninth Grade on Track to Graduate from 82% to 90% by June 11,

The second goal is to improve grades 9-12 Regular Attenders from 72% to 80% by June 11, 2020. The final goal is to improve the 4 year Cohort Graduation Rate to 90% by June 1, 2020.




